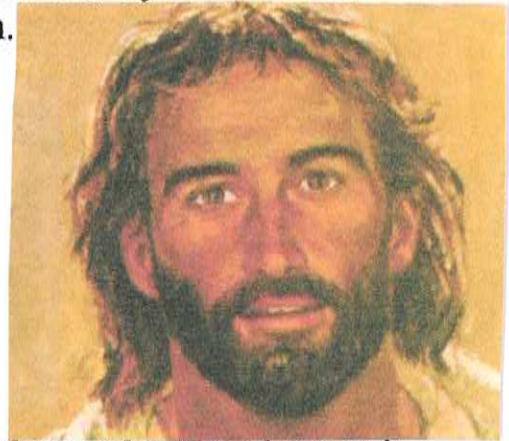


Sunday, January 24, 2021

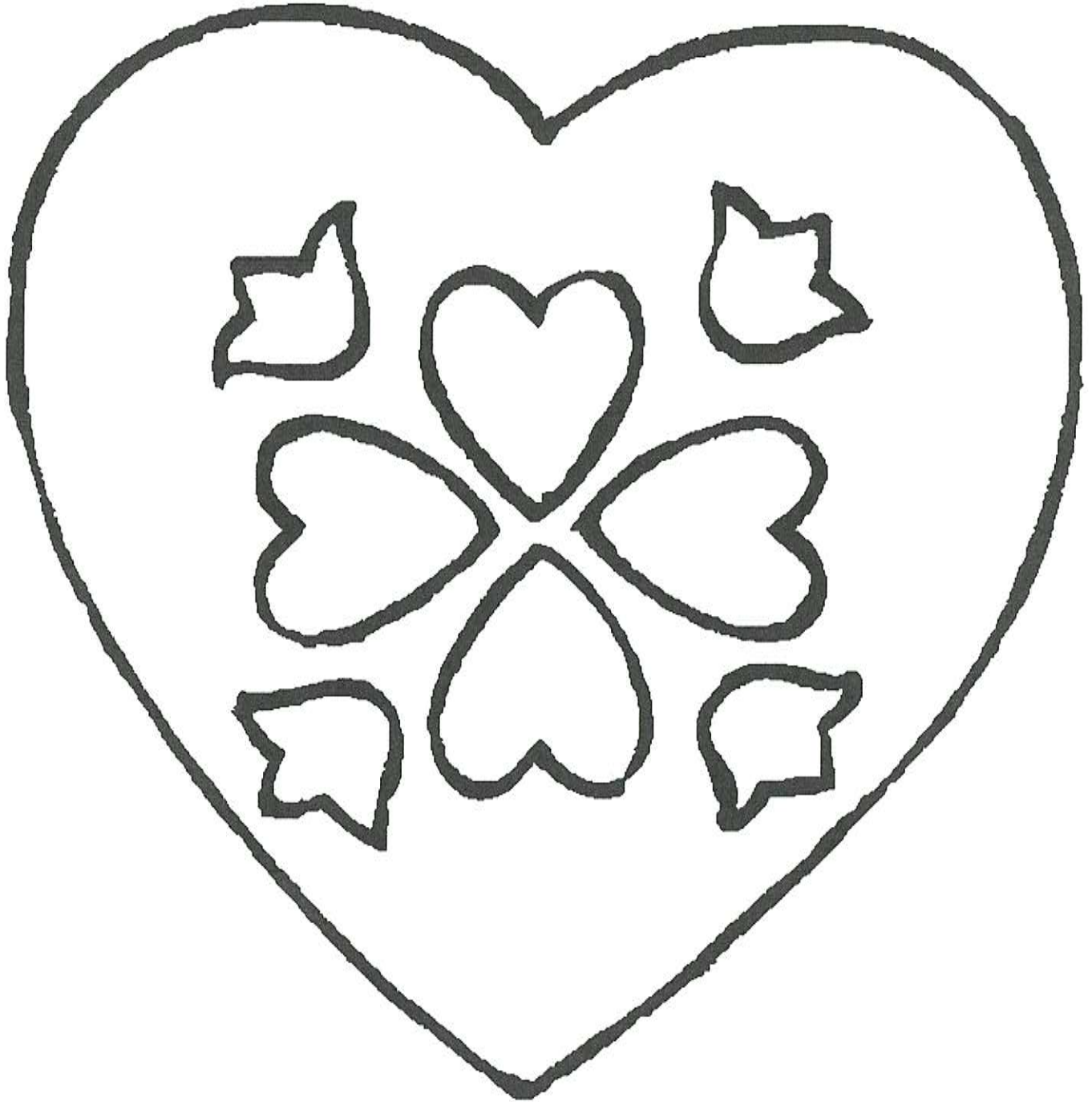


COME FOLLOW ME!

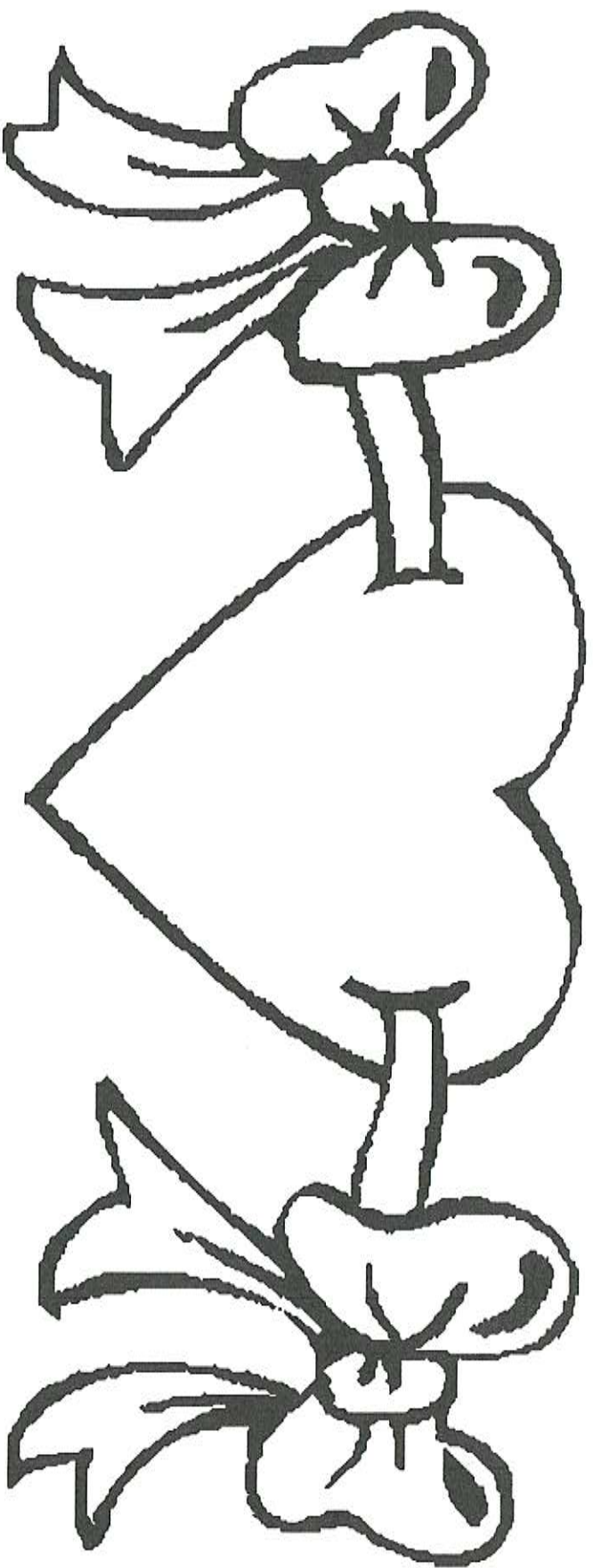
